

# Scholarship Policy Document

## Academic Year: 2026–27

### Introduction

At 10X International School, Bangalore, we believe in nurturing academic excellence, leadership potential, and well-rounded development in students from all backgrounds. In alignment with our core values of academic excellence, social equity, and nation-building, we offer a merit-based scholarship programme to deserving students entering Grades 9 through 12 for the academic year 2026–27.

## Assessment Criteria

All scholarship applicants will be evaluated based on:

- Academic Performance
  - Admissions Assessment scores
  - Report cards from previous two academic years
- Extracurricular Involvement
  - Certificates and records of participation
  - Relevance, level (school, state, national), and achievements

## Application & Selection Process

### **Step 1:** Admission Application

Submit a completed application for admission into Grade 9–12. Indicate interest in applying for a scholarship during the admissions process.

### **Step 2:** Scholarship Application Submission

Submit the following documents:

- Previous school academic reports (last two years)
- Certificates of extracurricular achievements
- Any supporting letters or documents (optional)

### **Step 3:** Scholarship Evaluation

Evaluation by the Scholarship Committee based on merit and holistic profile. Shortlisted candidates may be invited for an interview (online or offline).

### **Step 4:** Award Notification

Results will be communicated via email along with the admissions decision. The awarded scholarship amount will be adjusted in the second installment of the annual fee.

## Renewal Criteria

Scholarships are awarded for one academic year. Renewal for subsequent years will depend on:

- Maintaining a minimum academic score of 85% aggregate
- Continued involvement in school activities or external competitions
- Good disciplinary record
- Annual review by the Scholarship Committee

## General Terms and Conditions

- Scholarships are limited in number and awarded at the sole discretion of the school.
- Incomplete or falsified documents will result in disqualification.
- Scholarships are not transferable and cannot be converted to cash.
- If a student withdraws mid-year, the scholarship is deemed void.
- The school reserves the right to revoke a scholarship in case of poor academic or behavioural performance.
- The scholarship applies only to tuition fees and not to transport, boarding, meals, or examination fees. A detailed fee break-up is provided in Annexure 1.
